Senator Jeffrey V. Kessler (D-Marshall) continues to support legislation which promotes the acceptance of the homosexual lifestyle....the greatest threat to the traditional family of our day! For instance, consider the following FACTS regarding legislation he has both supported and opposed:

Senator Kessler SUPPORTED

Fair Housing & Employment for Homosexuals

2008-2007 (Senate Bill-600 & Senate Bill-686) - This legislation would have recognized bi-sexual, homosexual, and gender identity (sex change) as a "civil rights" category under the WV Human Rights Act and mandated employers and landlords to hire and rent to this group and be sued if found in violation.

During the 2008 legislative session, Senator Kessler cleverly utilized Clinton E.O. #13087 - "Equal Employment Opportunity Based on Sexual Orientation" to convey to his Senate colleagues the necessity for passage of SB-600 to bring West Virginia in line with federal law. Clinton's E.O. mandates non-discrimination for "sexual orientation" in employment within federal agencies, **but has no authority whatsoever governing state law**. This tactic led to a lopsided vote (32-0-2 absent) in the Senate in favor of this legislation. Several senators signed a letter, after the vote, stating they believed they were complying with federal law and would **NOT** have voted for this legislation, if it had been fully understood. Hate Crime Legislation for Homosexuals

2001-2000 (Senate Bill-23 & Senate Bill-422) Senator Kessler sponsored this legislation two years in a row, making crimes against homosexuals a hate crime. While crimes against anyone should be punished to the fullest extent of the law, hate crime laws are being used by homosexuals across America to silence those who dare speak out against their decadent and immoral lifestyle choice.

Senator Kessler OPPOSED

A Constitutional Amendment Banning Homosexual Marriage

2008-2006 (Senate Joint Resolutions-SJR-16, SJR-8, & SJR-12) Senator Kessler has REFUSED to allow this legislation to be taken up and voted on in the Senate Judiciary Committee for three years in a row! Despite having enacted a Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) on April 4, 2000, it is still possible this law could be struck down in the future by the WV Supreme Court. Why shouldn't West Virginians be permitted to vote on erecting the highest wall possible to prevent activist judges from redefining marriage and the traditional family as has been done in Massachusetts, California, and more recently in Connecticut!
